

Chapter 30 جمع مؤنث سالم Sound Feminine Plural

- An ism that denotes plural (more than two)
 - for feminine
 - with addition of ات at the end (not part of word eg أَمْوَاتٌ or دُعَاءً)

Iraab of Sound Feminine Plurals		
فاعل مرفوع وعلامة رفعه الضمة	جاء الطالباتُ	رفع
مفعول به منصوب بالكسرة نيابة عن الفتحة لأنه جمع مؤنث سالم	رأيْتُ الطَّالِبَاتِ	نصب
اسم مجرور وعلامة جره الكسرة	مَرْأَتُ بِالْطَّالِبَاتِ	جر

Categories of Feminine Isms

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In terms of meaning

- المؤنث الحقيقي true feminine (biologically) - even if no sign of fem like ة eg فاطمة and زينب
- المؤنث المجازي not true feminine eg أرض and شمس

In terms of wording

- المؤنث اللفظي feminine in wording - with a sign of fem like ة eg طلحة and همزة
- المؤنث المعنوي feminine in meaning but no sign eg مريم and زينب

Note: some feminine isms can be in different categories at the same time

isms That Enter Sound Feminine Plural & Its Conditions

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- isms that ends with extra ة
 - be it a proper name or not eg تجارة فاطمة and همزة المؤنث اللفظي eg except words which will have broken plurals

مِلَّةٌ - مِلَّةٌ	قُلَّاتٌ - قُلَّةٌ	شِفَاهٌ - شِفَاهٌ	شَاهٌ - شَاهٌ	أَمَّةٌ - أَمَّةٌ	إِمَاءٌ - إِمَاءٌ	أَمْرَأَةٌ - نِسَاءٌ
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- isms that ends with alif maqsoorah or mamoodah (be it name or sifah) eg حمراء حمراوات مصطفى مصطفيات
- proper names that are real feminine but has no feminine sign eg زينب
- description of non-intelligent masculine words eg أَيَّامٍ مَعْدُودَاتٍ
- of non-intelligent masculine words eg نُهَيْرٌ - نُهَيْرَاتٍ and اسْمٌ تَصْغِيرٌ
- masdr eg تَعْلِيمٌ - تَعْلِيمَاتٍ

Words with irab just like sound feminine plural

- the word **أولات** has no singular & always use as a مضاف
eg 65:6 وَإِنْ كُنَّ أُولَاتٍ حَمْلٍ فَأَنْفِقُوا عَلَيْهِنَّ حَتَّىٰ يَضْعَفُنَ حَمْلُهُنَّ -
- words that becomes names of places or people
eg - **أذرعات** a place in Syam
eg - **نعمات** name of a person
eg 2:198 فَإِذَا أَفَضْتُم مِّنْ عَرَفَاتٍ فَادْكُرُوا اللَّهَ عِنْدَ الْمَشْعَرِ الْحَرَامِ -

Description of Non Human Plurals

Non human plurals can be described in the following ways:

1. BP with PF adjective eg أيام معدوداتِ
2. BP with SF adjective eg أيام معدودةً
3. PF with PF adjective eg آياتٍ بِيَنَاتٍ
4. PF with SF adjective eg آياتِنَا الْكَبْرِيَ
5. PF with BP Adjective eg سَبَلَاتٍ خَضْرٍ
6. BP with BP Adjective eg أَشْهُرٍ حَرَمٍ

- The overarching principle is that all non human plurals, broken or not, are normally treated SF. According to that guideline, 2, 4, 5 and 6 are normal expressions.
- When a non human plural regardless of whether it is broken like أيام or feminine combination like آيات is given a plural feminine treatment like in 1 and 3, this is the ancient arabic method of going out of ones way to describe the plural as somehow less. It becomes a treatment called جمع قلة.
