كُلْ كُلْ كُلْ special mudaf (RNJ) has different meanings.

كُلْ مُسْلِمٍ (each/every muslim) m.ilaih= singular/common

When كُلْ comes with m.ilaih thats singular/common

It becomes “each muslim”

Not for every m.ilaih, only when كُلْ is mudaf and

singuar/common m.ilaih, the meaning of كُلْ is “each”

Note: كُلُّ الْمَسْجِدِ (the entire masjid) m.ilaih=sing/proper

كُلُّ مَسْجِدٍ “each masjid”

Note: كُلُّ الْمُسْلِمِينَ “all of the muslims”

كُلُّ مُسْلِمٍ “each muslim”

كُلُّ الْمُسْلِمِ “the whole muslim”

Note: كُلُّ الطَّعَامِ “all food”

كُلُّ عَابِدٍ “each worshipper” (in arabic its incomplete= more will be said in the sentence about the m.ilaih) (general)

كُلُّ العَابِدِ “the entire worshipper”

كُلُّ الْعَابِدِينَ “all of the worshippers” (in arabic its complete= more doesnt have to be said) specific

Note: كُلُّ شَيْءٍ each thing/everything (general)

كُلُّ الْأَشْيَاءِ all of the things, all things (specific)

كُلُّ الشَّيْءِ the whole thing/the entire thing

Q&A: حتى is a hoj and a light harf, if it proceeds an ism will it make it light and jarr?) no حتى hoj, affects ism, makes it jarr. أَنْ لَنْ لِكَ إِذْنُ حتى (light harts) effects present tense fi'l and makes it light. Dont confuse them!
